
More than 70% of our workforce is women. We never "built for it" but it happened. One of the factors we observe when we take interviews or even on our platform - is a lack of confidence/ self-doubt among them.

Women feel unsure and underconfident in their ability to grow up the ladder or take up those senior roles - especially with life events like marriage, relocation, kids etc disrupting the normal career progression for us more than men.

What really helps is a strong female role model - in personal or professional lives which can help them overcome this mental hurdle.

One of the KPMG research found that women who had strong role models growing up (mother, teacher etc) grew up to be twice more confident (50% vs 25%) than those who did not.

The presence of women in leadership positions and the opportunity to network can help motivate women to advance in their careers. The research suggested nearly nine in 10 (88%) women are encouraged by the women they see in leadership today and more than eight in 10 (86%) noted that when they see more women in leadership, they are encouraged they can get there themselves.

This is something which has helped me during times of self-doubt. I try to find such amazing women and speak to them from time to time.

This Women's Day I thought of sharing this with you all in the form of a talk show where we bring such role models from different spheres of life (entrepreneurs, leaders, sportspersons etc) and get inspired by them.

As per the guidelines the colleges all over the country have to nominate students (Boy / Girl) as Gender Champions. In view of the above our Director General has advised that students may be encouraged to participate in Online Essay Writing Competition (Hindi / English) on the following topics in 300-400 words.
